Lastly, the analysis of individual speakers in this study shows that acquisition of more nativelike phonology does not necessarily proceed at the same rate of an increase in higher language proficiency, since the more proficient speakers in this study did not necessarily have higher rates of intelligibility than less proficient speakers. To analyze students' improvement of the mid vowels, diphthongization of these vowels was quantified. The analysis revealed that the primary difference in pronunciation errors is between A1 and A2 levels, as A1 speakers had a significantly higher level of pronunciation errors than A2, B1, and B2 speakers, which had comparable error rates between each other.
